### WaterSmart Contractor Incentive Program

A new WaterSmart rebate program will be launched by the San Diego County Water Authority this fall that will benefit property owners from incentives on irrigation hardware and promote efficiency upgrades via landscape contractors. The highlights of this latest rebate program is easy enrollment, faster processing time and an increase in rebates for high-efficiency sprinkler nozzles. Typical sites include commercial (including HOAs), industrial, institutional and agricultural properties. Must be one acre or more of irrigated landscape but there is no maximum limit, with a minimum to install at least two of the measures.

Incentives by device include:

- \$35 per Smart Irrigation Controller
- \$6 per High-Efficiency Sprinkler Nozzle
- \$60 per Flow Sensor
- \$0.20 per square foot of drip irrigation

The program time-line is 90 days to complete once your rebate is reserved. Time is of the essence to take advantage of this program! **Funding is limited so be sure to act on your request by December 1st!** If you are thinking about upgrading your irrigation, contact us soon to get a head start on this taking advantage of this program!

**Plant Spotlight - Cercis  
Canadensis 'Forest Pansy'**



A great alternative to the Ornamental Plum which has been a great tree used for its purple leaf color (but is also prone to disease and insect issues) - the 'Forest Pansy' has nice arching branches with interesting slightly zig zag growth pattern. Between the branch nodes are purple leaves that change color in late summer and it produces nice spring flowers without the messy fruit afterwards.
